We had a lovely Visit from Liz Kendall who was keen to know all about the challenges we are facing in a school during the current pandemic.



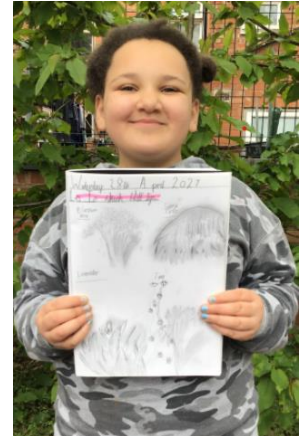
Bank Holiday Monday

Year 1

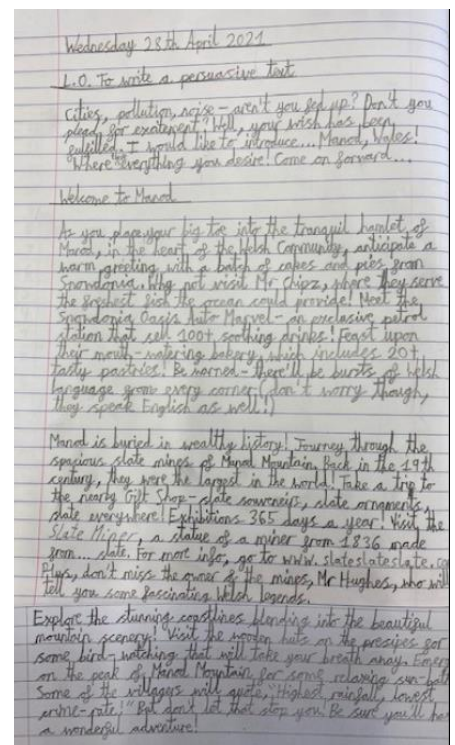
Year 1 have been writing 'Lost' posters for a missing tiger! Aaliyah used super adjectives to describe him.
