Solving Problems

Getting to School on Time!

There are still far too many children arriving late for school – arriving late is disruptive and unfair on your child and their classmates. Please remember that if your child is going to be late that they sign in at the office.

School starts at 8.45 (8.40 for F1) and we expect children to be in school 5 minutes before the start of the day ie at 8.40 or 8.35.

Please note that children should not be coming to school before 8.30 unless they are going to Breakfast Club because they cannot be supervised at this time.

So, there is a 10 minute 'window' from 8.30 until 8.40 for children to arrive at school.
