## Food Glorious Food!!!

We have some information regarding food that we need to bring to your attention.

Firstly, a reminder that we have a 'NO NUTS IN SCHOOL' policy in order to protect children with allergies to nuts or products containing nuts. Please respect this policy. I would also like to remind you that we have a water only policy in school – we hope that all children will bring a bottle to school every day that they can refill at various points around the school. This will become increasingly important as the year progresses and the weather becomes warmer but, in any event, staying well hydrated is extremely important to aid effective learning.
