

Parental Conduct – Important Notice

All staff and children have the right to work in a safe and calm environment.

We expect all adults to behave in a respectful manner at all times while on school premises.

We will not tolerate rude and abusive behaviour – this includes spreading ‘gossip’ about children, other families or members of staff or swearing at staff, children or other parents.

Social media such as Facebook needs to be used in a responsible and respectful way.

All abusive behaviour is reported to the police and may result in legal proceedings.

We work extremely hard at helping children to learn how to behave and treat other people.

Misunderstandings and disagreements are part of life but we still expect everyone at Fosse Primary to set a good example to children by behaving in a calm and respectful way to everyone within the school community.

If you have a problem we will work with you to sort it out.

If you need support we will work with you to find solutions.

If your child is unhappy we will listen and see how we can help them.
