## Invacuation procedures – please note these carefully

All schools need to prepare for unforeseen events. As part of this, we have re-written our 'Invacuation / Lockdown' Policy. This process would happen if there is an emergency on the school site such as an intruder, a dog loose in the school grounds or a fire in a nearby building. In the event of any serious occurrence, children outside the school building are brought inside to be kept safe – this is the opposite of a fire drill. Should we ever have to do this for real we will text all parents immediately with the following text: *There is a lockdown situation at Fosse Primary. Children are being kept safe inside. Do not contact the school – we will keep you fully informed.*

We have already held an Invacuation Drill which was very successful – like our termly Fire Drills, children were extremely sensible, following instructions perfectly. The full policy can be found on the school website.
